

BALD CYPRESS

FAMILY: CUPRESSACEAE
SCIENTIFIC NAME:
TAXODIUM DISTICHUM

DESCRIPTION: CAN LIVE UP TO 600 YEARS, AND IS USUALLY FOUND NEAR STREAMS, RIVERS, AND SWAMPS WITH SLOW-MOVING WATER. THEY GROW THROUGHOUT THE ATLANTIC COASTAL REGION. THE MASSIVE, BUTTRESSED TRUNKS DEVELOPED IN RESPONSE TO GROWING IN SOFT, WET SOIL.
