



WINGED SUMAC

FAMILY: *ANACARDIACEAE*

**SCIENTIFIC NAME: *RHUS*
*COPALLINUM***

DESCRIPTION: NATIVE SMALL TREE; THE COMMON NAME REFERS TO DISTINCTIVE 'WINGS' ON THE LEAF STEM BETWEEN THE LEAFLETS. WINGED SUMAC BEARS CLUSTERS OF RED BERRIES IN FALL. IT IS THE HOST OF LARVAE TO THE RED-BANDED HAIRSTREAK BUTTERFLY.
